Who should register?

- All guests planning to attend the event should register. Due to space constraints, we ask that parents and guardians refrain from attending the day's events and concerts. The concerts will be livestreamed.

When should guests arrive?

Guests of Little Dragons (2- and 3-year-olds)

Arrive at the Primary Building between 8:15-8:45 a.m. to check-in and enjoy a light continental breakfast in the Primary Building.

• Guests of Pre-Kindergarten Students

Arrive at the Primary Building between 8:15–8:30 a.m. to check-in and enjoy a light continental breakfast in the Primary Building. The Pre-K concert begins at 8:45 a.m. in the Primary Building Multipurpose Room.

• Guests of Kindergarten Students

Arrive at the Primary Building between 8:15–8:45 a.m. to check-in and enjoy a light continental breakfast in the Primary Building.

• Guests of Grades 1-5 Students

Arrive at the Lower School Building between 8:15–8:45 a.m. to check-in and enjoy a light continental breakfast in the Manor House Parlors.

• Guests of Grades 6-8 Students

Arrive at the Middle School between 8:15–8:30 a.m. to check-in and enjoy a light continental breakfast in the Middle School Lower Lobby. The Middle School Concert begins at 8:45 a.m. in the Mulitz Theater.

Where do guests park?

- Parking will be available in the Primary, Manor House, Middle and Upper lots as well as on the Teardrop (grassy area in front of the Manor House). Members of our operations staff will be out directing traffic that morning.
- Pudge buses will be available to transport guests between the buildings and parking areas. They will pick up and drop off at the Primary Building, Manor House, and Middle School/Mulitz Theater.
