

Who should register?

- All guests planning to attend the event should register. Due to space constraints, we ask that parents and guardians refrain from attending the day's events and concerts. The concerts will be livestreamed.

When should guests arrive?

Please see below to find guest check-in locations and arrival times by student grade level. A light breakfast will be available for guests during check-in.

Wednesday, April 1

- Guests of **Little Dragons 2s** should arrive at the **Primary Building** between **9:15–9:45 am**.
- Guests of **Little Dragons 3s** should arrive at the **Primary Building** between **8:30–9 am**.
- Guests of **Pre-K and Kindergarten** should arrive at the **Primary Building** between **8:45–9:15 am**.
- Guests of **Grades 6–8** should arrive at the **Middle School** between **8:30–9 am**.

Thursday, April 2

- Guests of **Grades 1–2** should arrive at the **Middle School** between **8:30–9 am**.
- Guests of **Grades 3–5** should arrive at the **Lower School** between **8:30–8:45 am**.

Where do guests park?

- Parking will be available throughout the campus each day. GCS operations staff will be directing parking—please pay attention.
- **Student drop-off runs until 8:20 a.m. Guests arriving early should not attempt to walk on campus until drop-off has ended.**
- Shuttle buses will be available after drop-off to transport guests between buildings. For those who need extra assistance, golf cart service will be available between parking areas and buildings.

My child's guest has never been to the school; what do they need to know?

- Be sure guests know their grandchild's grade level. Provide the guest with the schedule of events and highlight the schedule that applies to them. Printed schedules will be available at check-in on both Wednesday and Thursday. Faculty and staff will be available to assist guests.
- If you have grandchildren in more than one division, you will not be able to attend all events in each division. Please look over the schedule and discuss with your grandchildren which activities they would most like you to attend.

What time is the event over?

- Guests are welcome to leave when they are ready or stay until 11:30 a.m. Parent permission is needed to release students to their guest for dismissal.
- Wednesday, April 1 is a full day of school for students. There is a noon dismissal on Thursday, April 2.
